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What is Microsoft Forms?



- Forms is a free tool from Microsoft.
- It is possible to create questionnaires, forms and polls.
- It is possible to view the answers, analyse the data and export them to Excel.



How to test E:

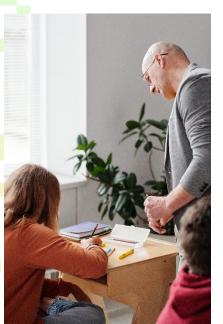
- 1. To start Microsoft Forms you must use your Microsoft 365 school/work credentials or your personal Microsoft account (Hotmail, Live Outlook.com).
- 2. Then, "New Questionnaire" or "New Form" is selected, depending on the intended goal (the questionnaire refers to the evaluation, while the form collects data).
- 3. After creating, it is possible to preview its appearance, test and share through a link or QR code.
- 4. To view the forms answers, this tool provides an overall summary, enables individual analysis and data export to Excel.











1. Functionalities supporting Blended Learning

- a. Supporting Professional Engagement
- b. The tool is very intuitive and simple.
- c. However, it is beneficial to use the description option to clarify the participant and avoid filling out the form/questionnaire incorrectly.





2. Supporting Digital Resources

- a. There are several online support, developed by Microsoft Forms, such as:

- c. Create a form or questionnaire (read online support).
- d. Share (read online support).
- e. View results (read online support).

- a. Microsoft Forms enhances the formative and summative assessment of students and the implementation of gamification in the classroom.
- b. Providing immediate feedback, engaging questions and, consequently, funnier learning and detailed statistics of the answers.

- a. Microsoft Forms allows the operationalization of the online assessment, which may prioritize formative and continuous assessment, evaluating processes and interactions whenever possible.
- b. Microsoft Forms is one of the tools that allows to take advantage of the potential of gamification in the classroom.
